

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Regulations for Policies and Procedures on Acquiring the Certification of Orientation for Appropriate Car Seat Installation

The Commission for Traffic Safety, in accordance with Section 2.1 of Act No. 38 of June 30, 2017, as amended, known as the "Uniform Administrative Procedures Act of the Government of Puerto Rico," publishes this notice for the above proposed Regulation.

This Regulation is intended to implement the process of guidance on the proper installation of protective seats and those other elevated, known as "booster seat" and the process of obtaining Certification issued by a Certified Technician of the Puerto Rico Fire Department or the Traffic Safety Commission.

This Regulation is adopted and disseminated according to the responsibilities and powers conferred to the Traffic Safety Commission and the Puerto Rico Fire Department, through Section 3.03 of Act Number 22 of January 7, 2000, as amended, known as "Traffic and Vehicles Law of Puerto Rico".

The text of the proposed Regulation will be available during working days and hours at the Traffic Safety Commission located at the Minillas Government Center, South Building, Office 501, Avenida de Diego, Santurce, Puerto Rico.
